## Titan track finishes first



Dylan Fischer, Keegan Casey and Damian Fischer boomed in the 3200-meter run with Stewart coming in first, Fischer, second and Casey, third. Deshler's Mason Roth was fourth in the race.

The Thayer Central boys ran to first place at the Del Wicks Invitational in Deshler April 12. The Titans finished with a whopping 159 points. Superior was second at 78 points. Deshler had 69 for third place.

Titan victories for the meet were in no shortage, beginning with Aubrey Fangmeier, Zach Koss and Trey Fischer taking first, second and third places in the 800-meter run. Fangmeier ran it in 2:00.70 for first. Koss was second in 2:08.00 and Fischer, third, in a time of 2:15.00.

A second accomplishment was seen in the 3200-meter with Damian Stewart taking the win in 10:41.40; Dylan Fischer in 10:54.30 for second place; and Keegan Casey, third place in 11:01.50.

Another third hit came in the 1600-meter run. It was Casey for first place in 5:03.20. Stewart was second in 5:12.10.

The relays saw the boys take two firsts in the 1600 and 3200.

Thayer Central's 1600 team of Dylan Fischer, Koss, Phillip Price and Fangmeier in the anchor position came in at 3:40.80. In the 3200, it was Luke Templin, Trey Fischer, Andrew Heinrichs and Andrew Landsmann in 9:37.50.

Price was hot on the hurdles. In the 110, he scaled first in 17.00. For the 300, Price finished second in 44.50.

Additional notable gains were Casey's second place in pole vault behind Friend with a vault of 11 feet.

Fangmeier and Koss took the top two Titan spots in the 400-meter dash. Fangmeier was second in 51.60. Koss was fourth in 53.50.

Thayer Central was also second in the 400-meter relay. Isaiah Keilwitz, Jarod Hergott, Dominic Stewart and Price ran it in 48.48.

Kevin Burd took a third place in the long jump, going 17 feet, 9 inches.

Two days earlier, the Titans traveled to Smith Center for the Redman Relays and placed fourth overall with 72

points. Beloit, Norton Community and Phillipsburg were first, second and third, respectively.

The Titan 400 relay team of Keilwitz, Burd, Jarod Hergott and Price were first in 48.48. In the 1600 relay, Heinrichs, Templin, Dominic Stewart and Trey Fischer took the high road, placing first in 3:54.06.

In the second heat of the 3200 relay finals, Casey, Trey Fischer, Dylan Fischer and Fangmeier were first in 8:26.7. The time is good for a meet record.

Fangmeier was first in the 800 at 2:01.27 for 10 points.

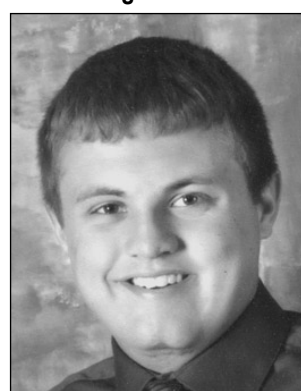
