

Titans compete in multi-class invitational

The Auburn Invitational scheduled for Dec. 17 was postponed because of inclement weather.

The Titans struggled in the Dec. 10 Crete Invite with just one Titan wrestler, Hank Harris (220 pounds) making it to the first place match in his class, but losing in a 8-5 decision to Connor Fee of Gretna.

There were 16 varsity teams at the invite, ranging in class B to D. Class B Gretna came in first at the invite with 252 points. Fairbury (181 points) was second and Crete (142.5 points), third. Thayer Central finished 13th with 40.5 points.

Harris placed second and scored 18 points for the team. He downed Tate Bulling of Crete in a 2:45 fall and in the semifinal, Harris won by a 9-3 decision over Noah Carlson of Central City.

Results are as follows: Scylar Roop (120 weight class) received a bye in his first consolation round and Tad Moldenhauer of Wilber-Clatonia sealed the second consolation round through a 9-1 major decision.

Keegan Casey (126) won in the consolation semifinal round via a tech fall in 3:18 over Lance Dybdal of Seward. Casey fell in 1:33 to Austin Barnits of Fairbury in the third place match.

In the quarterfinal, Casey won by an 8-7 decision over Gavin Howard of Omaha Bryan and then lost to Tyler Cunningham of Gretna in another decision round of

6-0. Casey placed fourth and scored 13.50 points.

Damian Stewart (132) of Ralston won by a fall over Trey Talmadge in 3:26 in the second consolation round and fell to Sam Hansen of Gretna in the third. The fall came at 1:18. Stewart had won by a 13-3 major decision against Alex Davenport of Waverly in the first round. He then fell to Drew Trautman of Wilber-Clatonia in 1:34. Stewart scored six points.

Jarod Hergott (138) received two byes and lost out to two decisions in the quarterfinal and the third consolation round to Luke Peterson of Central City and Blake Sears of Crete. The decisions were 6-0 and 7-1, respectively.

Jackson Feulner (145) was up against Keegan Pope of Syracuse, who won by a fall in 2:50 and Carson Johansen of Crete, who took the round in a 4-1 decision.

Ryan Koch (170) contended with Anthony Krueger of Syracuse, who won the round in a 7-3 decision and Tom Kienow of Gretna, who had the round after a 12-2 major decision.

Dietric Kenning (182) picked up his second consolation round for a fall over Billy Le of Lincoln Northstar in 4:11. In the next round of competition, Kenning fell to Jacob Schwisow of Crete in 2:44.

Kenning had received a bye in the first round and lost in the quarterfinal to Jared Gasper of Ralston in a 1:30 fall. Kenning scored three team points.

Brendon Fangmeier (285) wrestled the quarterfinal and first round consolation, competing against Zach Wioskowski of Adams Central and Kaleb Kramer of Gretna. Wioskowski won the first contest in a 2:26 fall and Kramer won by a 8-0 major decision.

Junior varsity

Six teams competed in the Bob Oliver Pin Invitational in Daykin Dec. 10 — Superior took the meet with 102.5 points. Thayer Central came in second with 50 points. Palmyra (46.25) was third. Remaining teams in the contest were Fairbury junior varsity, Dorchester and Meridian.

Results are as follows: Cody Fitzgerald (6-3) achieved a first place win with 25 points earned. He won all three contests. Fitzgerald pinned Wyatt Haverluck of Meridian in 3:28; Breden Jensen of Superior in 17 seconds; and Keyten Pfingsten of Fairbury in 4:34 for the first place match.

Cavan McCuistion (126 weight class) placed second and scored 10 points for the team. He was pinned in 5:56 by Seth Gehle of Superior in round one. In round two, McCuistion pinned Devin Holiday of Fairbury in 4:19.

Cade Friendly (160) was second with 15 team points. Friendly pinned Hektor Kuzelka of Fairbury in 1:15 and Tregan Moody of Fairbury in 1:27 to advance to round three, where he lost to Jason Jensen of Dorchester in a 9-2 decision.

Eagles come from behind in scrappy Sutton game

The Class C2 Sutton Mustangs came to Davenport Dec. 13 for an early season battle with the D1 Bruning Davenport Shickley Eagles.

Both teams were preseason rated in prep news, so it was a chance to get a good measure on where they stood before the Holiday break.

The teams went back and forth for most of the first quarter. As the clock ticked away, Kale Keinschmidt made a crossover move at the top of the key and hit a 12-foot floater in the lane to give the Eagles the early 16-13 advantage.

"I thought both teams did a good job early on of playing to their strengths," BDS Head Coach Fred Kluck commented. "We are both fairly physical and we both hit some tough shots to keep it close."

The second quarter was a different story. The Mustangs went to work both inside and out hitting three, 3-point shots and getting to the offensive

boards while building a 12-point half time margin, 36-24, after leading by as many as 15 prior to the break.

"We were really back on our heels in the locker room. Sutton really took it to us. We challenged them to come out and put up a little better showing to see if we could cut the lead down and have a chance in the fourth quarter," Kluck said.

The Eagles did just that, cutting the lead to six points, but as time ran down in the third quarter, Sutton stepped up big with a 3-point shot at the buzzer, giving them a 48-39 margin to enter the final period.

From there, it was a real battle as the Eagles clamped down on the defensive end, holding the Mustangs to just five, fourth quarter points and a Noel Gines 3-pointer as well as a steal and assist by Keinschmidt.

The pressure helped BDS tie the game and take the lead

down the stretch, hitting just enough free throws to hold off Sutton and complete the comeback for a 57-53 win.

"I was very proud of the fight we put up after we got so far down," Kluck said. "A lot of teams playing a bigger school with such a solid basketball tradition as Sutton has would have said it's not possible and quit. Our kids didn't and that's a real testament to their fortitude."

Leading scorers for BDS were Caden Norder with 13, Anthony Beavers with 11 and Kleinschmidt with 10. Kleinschmidt and Norder added three assists each with Kleinschmidt and his high of seven rebounds. Gines scored eight points, while John Christensen added seven and Holden Stengel, six to complete the scoring.

The Eagles will be in action Dec. 28 for a three-day holiday tournament, hosted by Nebraska Wesleyan University in Lincoln.

Lady Eagles battle for lead against Sutton Fillies

The Lady Eagles of Bruning Davenport Shickley lost by just three points against the Sutton Fillies in a Dec. 13 contest for a final score of 50-47.

The Eagles' first possession by TaraLee Hudson was a healthy pass from Carley Elznic, but the BDS offense struggled from there and didn't nail its flow until the third quarter. Sutton took a 5-point lead going into halftime. During the halftime break, the Lady Eagles discussed using their strength.

"Despite getting some points in the paint, our defense couldn't get the stops it needed to take the lead," Coach Shana Gerberding said. "We just couldn't stop their drives and they were knocking shots down off the drives."

Gerberding said the girls will regroup this week to focus on their defensive strategy needed to take the lead in games.

Elznic led in points with

13 while pulling 14 rebounds down. Regan Alfs racked up 12 points for the team. Megan Grote scored all her eight

points in the second quarter. Hudson and Lexi Kadel had five points each. Jadyn Kleinschmidt had four.

Tegtmeier Named GPAC Player Of The Week

Morningside College's Ryan Tegtmeier, a 6-0 senior guard from Davenport, Neb., was named the Hauff Mid-America Sports/Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC) Men's Basketball Player of the Week for his performance in the Mustangs' 92-88 victory against Concordia University on Dec. 7 in Sioux City.

Tegtmeier poured in a game and season's high 28 points to finish three points shy of his career scoring high. He made 10 of 19 field goal attempts, including a four-for-seven performance from the 3-point arc, and went four-for-four from the free-throw line to

shatter his previous season's scoring best of 17 points against Northwestern College. Twenty-one of his points came in the second half. Aside from his 28 points, Tegtmeier also led the Mustangs with four assists.

Tegtmeier, a four-year starter, has a career scoring average of 10.6 points per game and is the 18th leading scorer in Morningside history with 1145 career points.

Morningside is ranked 23rd in the nation in the NAIA Division II and will take an 8-4 record into this Friday's 8 p.m. home game against Midland University.
