



A Dry Time for the Holidays

New Year's Eve in the 1920s saw Nebraskans unable to legally include alcohol in their celebrations. Voters in this state had already adopted a prohibitory amendment to the state constitution in 1916, which took effect in May 1917, two years before the Eighteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution outlawed liquor nationwide.

As soon as legal drinking ended, however, enterprising bootleggers appeared to satisfy those who still wished to celebrate the holidays with their favorite alcoholic beverages.

Law officers were keenly aware that Christmas and especially New Year's were the best times of the year to raid suspected bootleggers.

The Alliance Herald on December 9, 1921, noted of a planned New Year's operation by law enforcement in Douglas County:

"Gloom is in store for Omahans planning to welcome the new year as in former times. U.S. Rohrer, federal prohibition enforcement officer, with his trusty sleuths, disguised in dress suits, intends to mingle

with the merry throngs on New Year's eve with eagle eyes, searching for scents of liquor on lip or hip.

He plans to seize both the liquor and liquored and send the latter off to prison. Those who bring their liquor with them will be charged with transportation, according to the sleuth. Plans of the intended coup leaked out the other day, much to the chagrin of Mr. Rohrer."

In a similar vein, the Herald reported a year-end raid on January 3, 1922: "The state prohibition enforcement agent and State Sheriff Gus Hyers overlooked a big bet when they concentrated their forces on Omaha for New Year's.

Hemingford, in Box Butte county, put on a party that, considering the size of the place, was entitled to rank with any celebration in the state."

Complaints about violators of the liquor laws at Christmas spurred local law enforcement, armed with warrants, to raid three buildings in Hemingford.

In one, they arrested "a crowd of men, who were engaged in pouring liquor from a keg into bottles, and jars, by the aid of a funnel, preparatory, so it is understood, to a visit to a dance that was to be held east of Hemingford that evening."

A December 1923 raid on an illicit still near Bridgeport in Morrill County prompted the Bridgeport News-Blade's headline: "Holiday Hootch Makers Come to Real Grief at Hands of Sheriff Davis When That Gentleman Made

Yuletide Raid." Accused of making "holiday hootch in rather large quantities," two Bridgeport area men and a fifteen-year-old son of one of them, had been arrested and their "moonshiner's cave" raided.

National prohibition ended in December 1933, and in November 1934 Nebraskans voted to end the state's constitutional prohibition, paving the way for legal drinking to once again be a part of holiday celebrations.

Nebraska Timeline

BY THE NEBRASKA STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY

A Count in Kearney: Felix von Luckner

The winter lyceum course, similar to the summer Chau-tauqua, presented cultural instruction and entertainment to rural Nebraskans in the years before autos, movies, and radio broadcasts made it obsolete.

The institution, which derives its name from Aristotle of ancient Greece, was founded in 1826 and spread to the frontier from eastern states.

Newspaper files at the Nebraska State Historical Society indicate its presence in Nebraska well into the 1930s.

One of the star attractions of the 1929 winter lyceum course offered by Kearney State Teachers College was a German count, Felix von Luckner (1881-1966), whose World War I exploits earned him the nickname the "Sea Devil."

He turned an old sailing ship, the Seeadler (Sea Eagle), into a German raider which sailed through the Allied naval blockade disguised as a Norwegian vessel, scuttling \$25 million worth of Allied shipping without taking a life.

The Kearney Daily Hub on November 26, 1929, reported that von Luckner "thrilled a large audience at the Kearney State Teachers college auditorium last night. His address was a part of the regular winter lyceum course presented by the college.

Von Luckner told of how, when a boy of thirteen, his adoration of Buffalo Bill led him to run away from home and join the crew of an old sailing vessel, to work his way to America.

The ship, bound for Australia, gave him his first real taste

of a sailor's life. At Australia Luckner boarded 'The Golden Shore,' a vessel headed for San Francisco. A tale of how he hiked across America in search of his ideal, . . . was dramatically told by the famous 'Sea Devil.'"

In a New York interview granted several months before his appearance as a lyceum speaker in Kearney, von Luckner recalled more details of his youthful enthusiasm for Buffalo Bill that led him to the United States.

Landing in San Francisco after running away from home, "he inquired where Buffalo Bill lived. When told the plainsman lived in Denver, he asked the way and a practical [man] pointed to an east-bound railroad track. Von Luckner penniless started out to walk to Denver—and did it, after five weeks!"

When he reached Cody's home in Denver, intending "to ask Buffalo Bill if I could ride with him and hunt buffalo over the plains of Colorado," he learned that his hero and the Wild West weren't in Denver—they were performing in Germany, a country to which von Luckner then returned and entered the German navy for an amazing career.


