

Today relays across the country, including Thayer County's event, include special moments to create an awesome experience such as the Survivors Lap. This special first lap of the event is for all cancer survivors to celebrate their victory over cancer. The victory usually includes lots of cheers and tears as the survivors walk and other participants gather around the track.

At the Hebron event, Relay also recognizes the caregivers who join survivors on the track celebrating their time, love, and support given to their loved ones, family, friend, neighbor, and coworkers facing and fighting cancer. Organizers encourage walking by participating in the "keep walking" laps to represent the stages a cancer patient must endure through their treatment.

A "fight back" ceremony is another powerful and emotional event that inspires Relay participants to take action. This ceremony symbolizes the

commitment that individuals have to fight against cancer.

After dark, a luminaria ceremony takes place to remember those who have been lost to cancer, honor those who have had cancer in the past, and support those whose fight continues. 
