As a team, the girls finished in fourth place with 62 points. Malcolm, Centennial and Hastings St. Cecelia took the top three spots, respectively.

The boys had 80 points to their credit and also placed fourth. Centennial was first, Hastings St. Cecelia, second, and Malcolm, third.

Topping the Titan girls’ victory list were Chloe Souerdyke in the high jump with 4 feet, 10.2 inches and Katelyn Richardson in the 800-meter run at a time of

2:29.56.

Souerdyke was also fourth in the 400-meter dash in 1:05.45.

Running fifth and sixth in the 800, Bridget Linton made it in 2:37.64 and McKenzie Johnson, 2:38.16.

Sydney Havel filled second and third spots in the hurdles. In the 300-meter, Havel was 50.85 for second. For the 100-meter, Havel secured third place in a time of 17.11.

In the women’s 3200-meter relay, Kaizley Krupicka, Chloe Souerdyke, Audrey Landsmann and Kylie Pachta made it to a third place medal in 11:33.02.

The 1600-meter relay team of Richardson, Linton, Krupicka and Chloe Souerdyke crossed the line

to fourth place. Their time was 4:32.60.

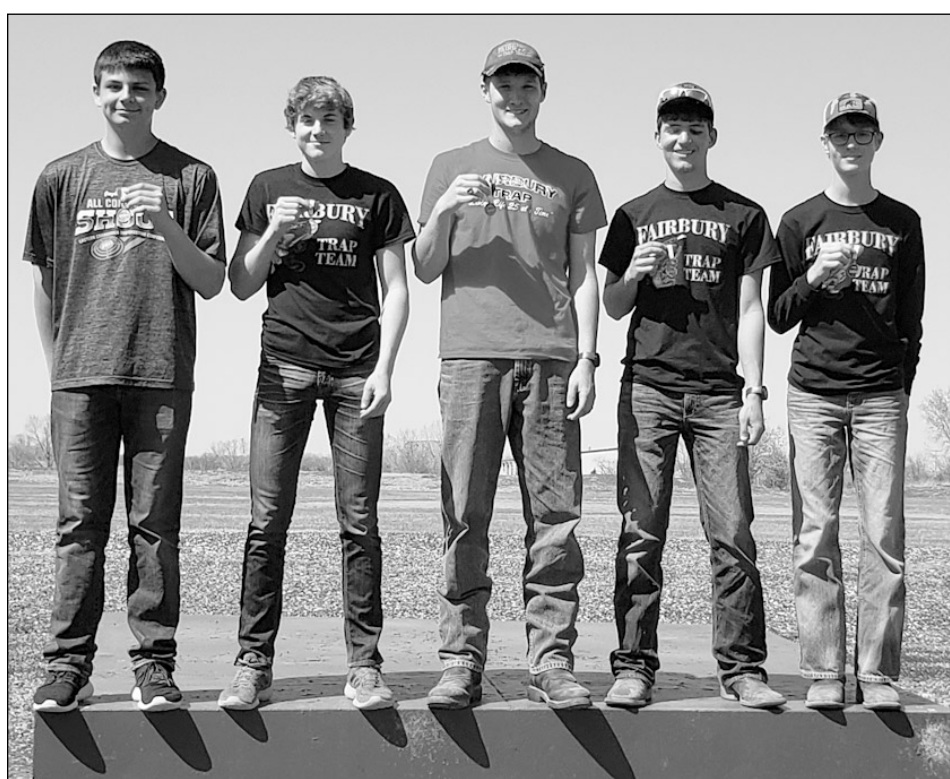
The team of Jena Cottam, Havel, Maddie Williams and Grace Souerdyke scored a fifth place in the 400-meter relay in 55.72.

Riskowski: Tax relief urgent

In the May 2 issue of the Hebron Journal-Register, candidates for Thayer County Clerk and the Nebraska Legislature were featured with the exception of candidate Al Riskowski, who is running for Sen. Laura Ebke's seat in the legislature.

In this week's issue, Riskowski's campaign is featured.

On property taxes, Riskowski said the issue won't be corrected overnight because it wasn't created overnight.

"Tax relief begins with controlling spending. In the short term, more money should be dedicated to direct property tax relief, and we need potential valuation for ag land," he said.

Riskowski hit the campaign trail months ago, speaking to groups and participating in forums with his opponents. But, his favorite method of connecting with voters is in person.

"I appreciate the chance to hear voters' individual concerns and answer their questions," Riskowski said. He feels potential constituents should hold him accountable.

Strengthening rural econ-

omies and school safety is also at the top of Riskowski's list. He also stands behind the Second Amendment.

"I'll protect the right to keep and bear arms," he stated.

Property tax relief is crucial to thriving communities as is investing in rural infrastructure, including broadband access to attract new investment and promote the existing employment opportunities in District 32.

"Nebraskans are in desperate need of property tax relief," he said. "People are disappointed the legislature was unable to deliver one penny of additional relief this year, despite the majority supporting a viable plan."

While he supports the Second, Riskowski believes schools should be more secure.

Decisions on security should be left up to local school boards and parents, he said.

"I believe in local control of education," Riskowski said.

His suggestion for schools is armed, off-duty law enforcement officers patrolling school grounds.

"No two schools or com-

munities are the same, and solutions to improve security will come from the bottom up, not from the top down," he said.

Riskowski has tackled serious issues in the past. He was the executive director of the Nebraska Family Alliance and a member of the Governor's Task Force on Human Trafficking.

"I worked with state senators on both sides of the aisle to direct new resources toward fighting human trafficking and raising awareness of its impact," he said. "Nebraska has made great strides, but we have much more work to do," he said.

He was director of the Alliance for 16 years and has 30 years of experience on the family farm.

Born in Omaha, Riskowski holds a degree in architecture. Later, he went into the ministry and he and his wife, Linda, ministered in churches, including spending seven years in Chappell and Christ's Place Church in Lincoln for 10 years.

Together, the Riskowskis have four children and six grandchildren, but according to his website, a seventh grandchild was on the way.
